#### NATIONAL PARK AUTHORITIES

##### *Status and constitution of authorities*

- 1 (1) A National Park authority shall be a body corporate.
- [<sup>F1</sup>(2) A National Park authority shall consist of—
- (a) a specified number of local authority members,
  - (b) in the case of a National Park in England, a specified number of parish members to be appointed by the Secretary of State, and
  - (c) a specified number of other members to be appointed by the Secretary of State;
- and “specified” means specified in the relevant order.
- (3) The total number of—
- (a) local authority members, and
  - (b) parish members,
- must exceed the number of other members.]
