1996 CHAPTER 17

An Act to consolidate enactments relating to [F²employment tribunals] and the Employment Appeal Tribunal. [22nd May 1996]

Be it enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—
