## PART XII

### INSOLVENCY OF EMPLOYERS

## 186 Limit on amount payable under section 182.

- (1) The total amount payable to an employee in respect of any debt to which this Part applies, where the amount of the debt is referable to a period of time, shall not exceed—
  - (a)  $[^{F1}£380]$  in respect of any one week, or
  - (b) in respect of a shorter period, an amount bearing the same proportion to  $[^{F2} \pounds 380]$  as that shorter period bears to a week.
