ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO AN ARBITRATION AGREEMENT

The arbitral proceedings

136 Legal or other representation.

Unless otherwise agreed by the parties, a party to arbitral proceedings may be represented in the proceedings by a lawyer or other person chosen by him.
