##### *Other miscellaneous provisions*

#### **69 Proof by written statement.**

- (1) In section 9 of the <sup>M1</sup>Criminal Justice Act 1967 (proof by written statement) in subsection (3)(a) (statement by person under 21 must give his age) for “twenty-one” there shall be substituted “eighteen”.
- (2) This section applies in relation to statements tendered in evidence on or after the appointed day.
- (3) The reference in subsection (2) to the appointed day is to such day as is appointed for the purposes of this section by the Secretary of State by order.
