1996 CHAPTER 42

7 Interpretation.

(1) In this Act—

[^{F1}“Board of Trustees” means the Board of Trustees of the Science Museum established under section 9 of the National Heritage Act 1983;]

“designated”, in relation to a record or artefact, means designated, or of a class or description designated, by the [^{F2}Board of Trustees] under section 3 above, and “designation” shall be construed accordingly;

“disposal”, in relation to a designated record or artefact, includes—

- (a) a lease or loan of the record or artefact for a period which exceeds twelve months, or for any period to a person to whom the record or artefact has been leased or loaned at any time in the preceding twelve months;
- (b) the creation of any security over the record or artefact,

and “dispose” shall be construed accordingly.

(2) In this Act expressions which are also used in the ^{M1}Railways Act 1993 have the same meanings as in that Act.
