Register of approved schemes

- 6 (1) The [FIRelevant Authority] shall maintain a register of schemes approved by the Secretary of State for the purposes of this Schedule and of the social landlords who are members of those schemes.
 - (2) The Secretary of State shall give notice to the [F2Housing Corporation]—
 - (a) when he grants or withdraws his approval of a scheme, and
 - (b) when he approves an amendment of a scheme,
 - and he shall supply the [F2Housing Corporation] with copies of any approved scheme or any amendment to a scheme.
 - (3) A member of the public shall be entitled, upon payment of such fees as the [F1Relevant Authority] may determine, to receive a copy of an approved scheme and a list of the social landlords who are members of it.
