[^{F1}SCOTTISH NATURAL HERITAGE'S DEER FUNCTIONS]

3 Power of [^{F1}SNH] to facilitate exercise of functions.

(1) [^{F1}SNH] shall have power—

- (a) to issue guidance or advice, whether general or particular, to any person or organisation; ^{F2}...
- (b) to conduct, or to collaborate with any person or organisation which is conducting—
 - (i) any research, inquiry or investigation into questions of practical or scientific importance; or
 - (ii) any experiment, trial or demonstration[^{F3}; and]

 $[^{F3}(c)$ to assist any person or organisation in reaching agreements with third parties,] relating to the conservation, control or sustainable management of deer or to any other aspect of $[^{F1}SNH's][^{F4}deer]$ functions

- (2) For the avoidance of doubt, it is provided that [^{F1}SNH] may exercise the powers conferred by subsection (1) above in relation to the general welfare of deer, in so far as that matter is not otherwise included in [^{F5}its] functions under this Act.
- [^{F6}(3) A public body or office-holder issued guidance or advice under subsection (1)(a) must have regard to such guidance or advice in exercising any functions to which the guidance relates.]
