

Chemical Weapons Act 1996

1996 CHAPTER 6

An Act to promote the control of chemical weapons and of certain toxic chemicals and precursors; and for connected purposes. [3rd April 1996]

Be it enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—
