Central supervision and direction

32 Reports from Director General.

- (1) The Secretary of State may [^{F1}, after consultation with the Scottish Ministers,] require the Director General of NCIS to submit to him a report on such matters connected with the activities of NCIS as may be specified in the requirement.
- (2) A report submitted under subsection (1) shall be in such form as the Secretary of State may specify.
- (3) The Secretary of State may arrange, or require the Director General to arrange, for a report under this section to be published in such manner as appears to the Secretary of State to be appropriate.
- (4) The Director General shall, as soon as possible after the end of each financial year, submit to the Secretary of State [^{F2}and to the Scottish Ministers] the like report as is required by section 11 to be submitted to the NCIS Service Authority.
