1998 CHAPTER 12

An Act to make provision for the establishment of the New Northern Ireland Assembly and for the election of its members. [7th May 1998]

Be it enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—
