Appeals

[F115A. Functions of Senior President of Tribunals

- (1) The Senior President of Tribunals shall ensure that appropriate steps are taken by the First-tier Tribunal to secure the confidentiality, in such circumstances as may be prescribed, of any prescribed material, or any prescribed classes or categories of material.
- (2) Each year the Senior President of Tribunals shall make to the Secretary of State F2... a written report, based on the cases coming before the First-tier Tribunal, on the standards achieved by the Secretary of State F2... in the making of decisions against which an appeal lies to the First-tier Tribunal.
- (3) The Lord Chancellor shall publish the report.
