Cases of error

28 Correction of errors and setting aside of decisions

- (1) Regulations may make provision with respect to—
 - (a) the correction of accidental errors in any decision [F1 of the Secretary of State] or record of a decision [F1 of the Secretary of State] made under any relevant enactment; F2...

- [F3(1A) In subsection (1) "decision" does not include [F4any decision of the First-tier Tribunal or] any decision made by an officer of the Inland Revenue, other than a decision under or by virtue of Part III of the Pension Schemes Act 1993.]
 - (2) Nothing in subsection (1) above shall be construed as derogating from any power to correct errors ^{F5}... which is exercisable apart from regulations made by virtue of that subsection.
 - (3) In this section "relevant enactment" means any enactment contained in—
 - (a) this Chapter;
 - (b) the Contributions and Benefits Act;
 - (c) the Pension Schemes Act 1993;
 - (d) the Jobseekers Act; F6...
