- (1) The [F³Assembly] shall issue, and may from time to time revise, a code of practice containing such practical guidance as [F⁴it] thinks appropriate with a view to securing effective relationships between local education authorities [F⁵in Wales] and the schools maintained by them—
- (a) in relation to promoting high standards of education in such schools; and
 - [F⁶(b) in relation to the discharge of such functions as the Assembly may determine for the purposes of this paragraph which are functions exercisable by or on behalf of such authorities in relation to such schools.]
- (2) In discharging their functions in relation to any maintained school [F⁷or maintained nursery school][F⁸in Wales], it shall be the duty of—
- (a) the local education authority,
 - (b) the governing body, and
 - (c) the head teacher,
