## THE POLICE FORCE

# 28 The [<sup>F1</sup>Police Fund].

- (1) The Secretary of State may by regulations provide—
  - (a) for the establishment, maintenance and operation of the [<sup>F1</sup>Police Fund]; and
  - (b) for the payment into that fund of—
    - (i) fines imposed on members of the police force in disciplinary proceedings; and
    - (ii) such other moneys as may be specified in the regulations.
- (2) The Secretary of State shall consult both the [<sup>F2</sup>Board] and the Police Association before making any regulations under this section.
