Special classes of person

40 **Mariners.**

For the purposes of this Act, an individual employed to work on board a ship registered in the United Kingdom under Part II of the ^{M1}Merchant Shipping Act 1995 shall be treated as an individual who under his contract ordinarily works in the United Kingdom unless—

- (a) the employment is wholly outside the United Kingdom; or
 - (b) the person is not ordinarily resident in the United Kingdom;
- and related expressions shall be construed accordingly.
