#### PROCEEDINGS IN NORTHERN IRELAND

### Notice of devolution issue

5 A court or tribunal shall order notice of any devolution issue which arises in any proceedings before it to be given to the [<sup>F1</sup>Advocate General for Northern Ireland and the Attorney General for Northern Ireland ] (unless the person to whom the notice would be given is a party to the proceedings).
