1999 CHAPTER 19

4 Relevant representative bodies.

- (1) The relevant representative bodies for the purposes of this Act are—
 - (a) British Chambers of Commerce;
 - (b) the body known as Scottish Chambers of Commerce.
- (2) The Secretary of State may by order amend subsection (1) by adding to or deleting from it the name of any body (whether corporate or unincorporated).
- (3) The power to make an order under this section is exercisable by statutory instrument which shall be liable to annulment in pursuance of a resolution of either House of Parliament.
