#### **60 Removal of restriction on use of evidence from computer records.**

Section 69 of the <sup>M1</sup>Police and Criminal Evidence Act 1984 (evidence from computer records inadmissible unless conditions relating to proper use and operation of computer shown to be satisfied) shall cease to have effect.
