TRAVEL CONCESSIONS

242 Requirements as to scope.

- (1) Arrangements under section 240(1) above for travel concessions for London residents meet the requirements of this section as to scope if they provide
 - ^{F1}(a) for the grant of travel concessions to all eligible London residents on journeys falling within subsection (2) below ^{F2}; and
 - ^{F2}(b) for the travel concessions granted to them to include the concession specified in subsection (8) below.]
- (2) [^{F3}The journeys referred to in subsection (1)(a) above] are journeys of a description falling within section 240(3) above, on the London Local Transport Network.
- (3) For the purposes of this Chapter, the London Local Transport Network consists of—
 - (a) bus services which together make up the London bus network within the meaning of section 181 above;
 - (b) services using a system of guided transport which are provided by Transport for London or under an agreement entered into by Transport for London under section 156(2) or (3)(a) above or under a transport subsidiary's agreement;
 - (c) railway services which are so provided;
 - (d) tramway services which are so provided; and
 - (e) services on the river Thames or a tributary of the river Thames which are so provided.

- (4) In subsection (3) above guided transport, railway and tramway have the same meanings as in section 240(6) above.
- (5) [^{F4}Subsection (1)(a) above does]not preclude the imposition of terms, limitations or conditions with respect to the particular journeys falling within subsection (2) above on which travel concessions are available.
- (6) Such terms, limitations or conditions may make different provision for different categories of eligible London residents.
- (7) In this Chapter a reference to a category of eligible London residents is a reference to [^{F5}a category specified in any one of the paragraphs]of section 240(5) above.
- [^{F6}(8) The travel concession which must be included is a [^{F7}waiver of the fare] for each journey on the London bus network which begins—
- (a) at any time on a Saturday or Sunday or on any day which is a bank holiday in England and Wales under the ^{M1}Banking and Financial Dealings Act 1971; or
 - (b) in the period from midnight to 4.30 a.m, or the period from 9.30 a.m. to midnight, on any other day.

- ^{F6}(10) The Secretary of State may by order amend this section for or in connection with securing that subsection (8) above provides for the reduction of fares to less than one-half of those applicable to adults who are not entitled to any reduction or for waiver of fares.]
