SCHEDULE 11

DETAINEE CUSTODY OFFICERS

Obtaining certificates of authorisation by false pretences

- 1 A person who, for the purpose of obtaining a certificate of authorisation for himself or for any other person—
- (a) makes a statement which he knows to be false in a material particular, or
 - (b) recklessly makes a statement which is false in a material particular,
- is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 4 on the standard scale.
