## [<sup>F1</sup>Core policing principles

## **31A** Core policing principles

- (1) Police officers [<sup>F2</sup>and National Crime Agency officers] shall carry out their functions with the aim—
  - (a) of securing the support of the local community, and
  - (b) of acting in co-operation with the local community.
- (2) In carrying out their functions, police officers [<sup>F3</sup>and National Crime Agency officers] shall be guided by the code of ethics under section 52.

[Nothing in this section shall have effect in relation to anything done by a National <sup>F4</sup>(3) Crime Agency officer outside Northern Ireland.]]
