## PART IV

#### STAFF

## Power to transfer staff to employment of Board

- 14 (1) The [<sup>F1</sup>Department of Justice] may by regulations provide for the transfer to the employment of the Board of any person to whom this paragraph applies.
  - (2) Subject to sub-paragraph (3), this paragraph applies to any person who immediately before such date as may be prescribed in regulations under sub-paragraph (1) ("the prescribed date") is—
    - (a) employed in the civil service; and
    - (b) engaged, in pursuance of arrangements under paragraph 13(2), in providing assistance to the Board.
  - (3) This paragraph does not apply to a person if—
    - (a) his employment in the civil service terminates on the day immediately before the prescribed date; or
    - (b) he is withdrawn from work with the Board with effect from the prescribed date.
  - (4) Before making any regulations under this paragraph the [<sup>F2</sup>Department of Justice] shall consult—
    - (a) the Board; and
    - (b) such organisations as appear to the [<sup>F2</sup>Department of Justice] to represent the interests of persons affected by the regulations.
