## SCHEDULE 3

#### DISTRICT POLICING PARTNERSHIPS

#### Independent members

- 4 (1) Appointments of independent members shall be made by the Board from among persons nominated by the council in accordance with paragraph 5.
  - [<sup>F1</sup>(1A) In appointing independent members of a DPP the Board shall so far as practicable secure that the members of the DPP (taken together) are representative of the community in the district.]
  - [<sup>F2</sup>(1B) Where, following a local government election, the Board has completed the appointment of the independent members of the DPP for a district, it shall publish notice of the date which is to be the reconstitution date in relation to the DPP for that district.
    - (1C) Notice under sub-paragraph (1B) shall be published in such manner as appears to the Board appropriate for bringing it to the attention of interested persons.]
      - (2) Subject to the following provisions of this paragraph, a person shall hold and vacate office as an independent member in accordance with the terms of his appointment.
      - (3) An independent member shall hold office until the [<sup>F3</sup>day before the reconstitution date] next following his appointment.
      - (4) A person appointed to fill a casual vacancy shall hold office for the remainder of the term of the independent member in whose place he is appointed.
      - (5) An independent member shall cease to hold office if—
        - (a) he resigns by notice in writing to the council; or
        - (b) he becomes disqualified for membership of the DPP.
      - (6) A person whose term of office as an independent member expires or who has resigned shall be eligible for re-appointment.
    - [<sup>F4</sup>(7) Where an independent member ceases to hold office at any time during the transitional period, no appointment shall be made to fill the casual vacancy; and paragraph 2 and sub-paragraphs (1) and (1A) of this paragraph shall have effect subject to this sub-paragraph.]
