##### SUPPLEMENTARY PROVISIONS

- 17 Land which is habitually used for the training of racehorses is not to be treated by virtue of paragraph 11 as excepted land except—
- (a) between dawn and midday on any day, and
  - (b) at any other time when it is in use for that purpose.
