Certificates

246 Certificates.

- (1) If the manager or trustee of a unit trust scheme which complies with the conditions necessary for it to [^{F1}be a UK UCITS] so requests, the [^{F2}FCA] may issue a certificate to the effect that the scheme complies with those conditions.
- (2) Such a certificate may be issued on the making of an authorisation order in respect of the scheme or at any subsequent time.
