FREEZING ORDERS IN RESPECT OF PROPERTY LIABLE TO FORFEITURE

Registered land: England and Wales

- 7 (1) The Land Charges Act 1972 (c. 61) and the [^{F1}Land Registration Act 2002] apply—
- (a) in relation to freezing orders, as they apply in relation to orders affecting land made by the court for the purpose of enforcing judgments or recognisances; and [^{F2}, except that no notice may be entered in the register of title under the Land Registration Act 2002 in respect of such orders]
 - (b) in relation to applications for freezing orders, as they apply in relation to other pending land actions.
