PATERNITY AND ADOPTION

Administration and enforcement: pay

13 Supply of information held by the Board

- (1) This section applies to information which is held for the purposes of functions relating to [^{F1}ordinary statutory paternity pay, additional statutory paternity pay] or statutory adoption pay—
- (a) by the Board, or
 - (b) by a person providing services to the Board, in connection with the provision of those services.
- (2) Information to which this section applies may be supplied—
- (a) to the Secretary of State, ^{F2}... or the Department, or
 - (b) to a person providing services to the Secretary of State, ^{F2}... or the Department, for use for the purposes of functions relating to social security, child support or war pensions ^{F3}....
