# [F12C Prosecuting authorities

- (1) Anything which the Director of Public Prosecutions is authorised or required to do under, or in relation to, Part 5 or 8 of this Act may be done by a member of his staff if the member of staff is authorised by the Director (generally or specifically) for that purpose.
- (2) Anything which <sup>F2</sup>... the Director of the Serious Fraud Office is authorised or required to do under, or in relation to, Part [<sup>F3</sup>2, 4,] 5, [<sup>F4</sup>7] or 8 of this Act may be done by a member of his staff if the member of staff is authorised by the Director <sup>F5</sup>...
