## 44 Appeal to [F1Supreme Court]

- (1) An appeal lies to the [F2Supreme Court] from a decision of the Court of Appeal on an appeal under section 43.
- (2) An appeal under this section lies at the instance of any person who was a party to the proceedings before the Court of Appeal.
- (3) On an appeal under this section the [F3Supreme Court] may—
  - (a) confirm the decision of the Court of Appeal, or
  - (b) make such order as it believes is appropriate.
