[^{F1}67C Sections [^{F2}67ZA to] 67B: appeals

- (1) If a magistrates' court decides not to make an order under section $[^{F3}67ZA(3), 67A(3)]$ or 67AA(2)], an appropriate officer may appeal to the Crown Court.
- (2) If a magistrates' court makes an order under section [^{F4}67ZA(3), 67A(3) or 67AA(2)], a person affected by the order may appeal to the Crown Court.
- (3) But the person mentioned in section [^{F5}67ZA(2)(a), 67A(3)(a) or 67AA(2)(a) (as applicable)] may not appeal.
- (4) An appropriate officer may appeal to the Crown Court against-
 - (a) a determination made by a magistrates' court under section 67B;
 - (b) a decision by a magistrates' court not to make a determination under that section.
- (5) In this section "appropriate officer" has the same meaning as in section 41A.]
