EXTRADITION TO CATEGORY 1 TERRITORIES

Matters arising before end of extradition hearing

24 Extradition request **U.K.**

- (1) This section applies if at any time in the extradition hearing the judge is informed that—
- a certificate has been issued under section 70 in respect of a request for the person's extradition;
 - the request has not been disposed of;
 - an order has been made under section 179(2) for further proceedings on the warrant to be deferred until the request has been disposed of.
- (2) The judge must remand the person in custody or on bail.
- (3) [^{F1}If the person is remanded in custody, the appropriate judge may]^{F1} later grant bail.
