2004 CHAPTER 17

9 Directions

- (1) A direction—
 - (a) must be given in writing;
 - (b) may be varied by a subsequent such direction.
- (2) A direction under section 2(2), (3) or (4)^[F1] or 2A(1),] must be given in regulations made by statutory instrument.
- (3) A statutory instrument making regulations giving a direction under section 2(2)(a) or (3)^[F2] or 2A(1)] is subject to annulment in pursuance of a resolution of either House of Parliament.
