CONSTITUTION

Membership

 - (2) The Secretary of State shall aim to ensure that the Distributor has at least 5 members at any time.
 - (3) Before making an appointment under sub-paragraph (1) the Secretary of State shall consult—
 - (a) the Mayor of London, and
 - (b) the National Olympic Committee.
