Licensing

17 Persons to whom licence applies

The authority conferred by a licence extends to-

- (a) the designated individual,
- (b) any person who is designated as a person to whom the licence applies by a notice given to the Authority by the designated individual, and
- (c) any person acting under the direction of—
 - (i) the designated individual, or
 - (ii) a person designated as mentioned in paragraph (b).
