### PART 3

#### MISCELLANEOUS AND GENERAL

##### *General*

#### 53 “Relevant material”

- (1) In this Act, “relevant material” means material, other than gametes, which consists of or includes human cells.
- (2) In this Act, references to relevant material from a human body do not include—
  - (a) embryos outside the human body, or
  - (b) hair and nail from the body of a living person.
