PENSION PROTECTION FUND COMPENSATION ETC.

Interpretation

37 (1) In this Part—

"assessment period" means—

- (a) an assessment period within the meaning of Part 2 of the Pensions Act 2004 (pension protection), or
- (b) an equivalent period under corresponding Northern Ireland legislation; "the Board" means the Board of the Pension Protection Fund;
- [F1: 'the civil partner with compensation rights' means the civil partner who is or is likely to be entitled to PPF compensation;]
- "the civil partner with pension rights" has the meaning given by paragraph 29(1);
- "occupational pension scheme" has the same meaning as in the Pension Schemes Act 1993 (c. 48);
