Residential property tribunals

## 231 Appeals from residential property tribunals

- (1) A party to proceedings before a residential property tribunal may appeal to the [F1Upper Tribunal] from a decision of the residential property tribunal.
- [F2(2) But the appeal may only be made with the permission of the residential property tribunal or the Upper Tribunal.]
  - (3) On the appeal—
    - (a) the [F3Upper Tribunal] may exercise any power which was available to the residential property tribunal, and
    - (b) a decision of the [F3Upper Tribunal] may be enforced in the same way as a decision of the residential property tribunal.
- [F4(4) Section 65A of the Rent Act 1977 (right of appeal from a rent assessment committee in Wales) does not apply to a decision of a residential property tribunal).]
