#### FINANCE

##### *Direction requiring payment to the Secretary of State*

- 7 (1) The Secretary of State may give a direction to the [<sup>F1</sup>PC] requiring it to pay him a sum specified in the direction.
- (2) Before giving a direction under sub-paragraph (1), the Secretary of State must consult—
- (a) the Treasury; and
  - (b) the [<sup>F1</sup>PC].
