PRIZE GAMING

288 Meaning of “prize gaming”

Gaming is prize gaming for the purposes of this Act if neither the nature nor the size of a prize played for is determined by reference to—

- (a) the number of persons playing, or
- (b) the amount paid for or raised by the gaming.
