48 Chief executive

- (1) The Supreme Court is to have a chief executive.
- [F1(2) It is for the President of the Court to appoint the chief executive.]
 - (3) The President of the Court may delegate to the chief executive any of these functions—
 - (a) functions of the President under section 49(1) [F2 or 51A(1)(a) or (b)];
 - (b) non-judicial functions of the Court.
 - (4) The chief executive must carry out his functions (under subsection (3) or otherwise) in accordance with any directions given by the President of the Court.
