



# Commissioner for Older People (Wales) Act 2006

## 2006 CHAPTER 30

### *Working with other ombudsmen*

#### **16 Working jointly with the Public Services Ombudsman for Wales**

- (1) This section applies where it appears to the Commissioner that—
  - (a) he is entitled to examine a particular case under regulations made under section 10; and
  - (b) the case is one which could also be the subject of an investigation by the Public Services Ombudsman for Wales.
- (2) Where the Commissioner considers it appropriate, he must—
  - (a) inform the Ombudsman about the case; and
  - (b) consult him in relation to it.
- (3) Where the Commissioner consults the Ombudsman under this section he and the Ombudsman may—
  - (a) co-operate with each other in relation to the case;
  - (b) conduct a joint examination of the case;
  - (c) prepare and publish a joint report in relation to the examination.
- (4) The [<sup>F1</sup>Welsh Ministers]<sup>F1</sup> may by order provide that this section is also to apply where it appears to the Commissioner that a case could be the subject of an investigation by a person who is specified in the order as if references in this section to the Public Services Ombudsman for Wales were references to that person.
- (5) Before making an order under subsection (4), the [<sup>F2</sup>Welsh Ministers]<sup>F2</sup> must consult the Commissioner and any other persons [<sup>F3</sup>they think]<sup>F3</sup> appropriate.
