#### **ENCOURAGING OR ASSISTING CRIME**

Inchoate offences

### Encouraging or assisting an offence believing it will be committed E+W+N.I.

A person commits an offence if—

- (a) he does an act capable of encouraging or assisting the commission of an offence; and
- (b) he believes—
  - (i) that the offence will be committed; and
  - (ii) that his act will encourage or assist its commission.
