## 2008 CHAPTER 10

### <sup>F1</sup>8 Consumer credit **E+W**

(1) The Consumer Credit Act 1974 (c. 39) does not regulate loans made in accordance with regulations under section 22 of the Teaching and Higher Education Act 1998 (c. 30).

[<sup>F1</sup>(1A) The Financial Services and Markets Act 2000 does not regulate loans made in accordance with those regulations.]

<sup>F2</sup>(2) [<sup>F2</sup>Subsection (1)] shall be treated as always having had effect.
