REGISTRATION

Eligibility

[^{F1}114A Local authorities: duty to notify

- (1) A local authority ^{F2}... which is not subject to compulsory registration must notify the regulator as soon as it becomes subject to compulsory registration.
- (2) For these purposes, an authority is subject to compulsory registration if—
 - (a) it is a provider of social housing, or
 - (b) it intends to become a provider of social housing.]
