### Panel's role in relation to application

### 75 Decision-making by the Panel

- [<sup>F1</sup>(A1) If the members of a Panel with two members disagree as to a proposed decision by the Panel, the view of the lead member is to prevail.]
  - (1) The making of a decision by [<sup>F2</sup>a Panel with three or more members] requires the agreement of a majority of its members.
  - (2) The lead member has a second (or casting) vote in the event that the number of members of the Panel agreeing to a proposed decision is the same as the number of members not so agreeing.
