#### SELF-BUILD SOCIETIES

#### 654 Delegation of powers to the Regulator of Social Housing

- (1) The Secretary of State may delegate to the Regulator of Social Housing any function of the Secretary of State under section 653 in a case where the function is exercisable in relation to a society whose registered office for the purposes of [<sup>F1</sup>the Co-operative and Community Benefit Societies Act 2014] is in England.
- (2) The function may be delegated—
  - (a) to any extent that the Secretary of State specifies, and
  - (b) subject to any conditions that the Secretary of State specifies.
