EXPLANATORY NOTES

COMMENCEMENT

- 175. Section 49 makes provision about commencement. Sections 1 to 38, 42, 45 and 47 (provisions to abolish the Audit Commission and establish the new local audit regime, related amendments and Parish meetings: parish polls) come into force by order made by the Secretary of State.
- 176. Section 39 (provisions to ensure compliance with the Code of Recommended Practice on Local Authority Publicity) and 40 (Access to local government meetings and documents) come into force 2 months after the Act is passed.
- 177. Section 41 (amendments to the council tax referendums provisions) comes into force on the day the Act is passed if that date is before 5 February 2014, otherwise the section comes into force by order made by the Secretary of State.
