#### CONDITIONS FOR SENSITIVE PROCESSING UNDER PART 4

##### *Vital interests of a person*

- 3 The processing is necessary—
- (a) in order to protect the vital interests of the data subject or of another person, in a case where—
    - (i) consent cannot be given by or on behalf of the data subject, or
    - (ii) the controller cannot reasonably be expected to obtain the consent of the data subject, or
  - (b) in order to protect the vital interests of another person, in a case where consent by or on behalf of the data subject has been unreasonably withheld.
