SEARCH WARRANTS: APPLICATIONS AND SAFEGUARDS

Safeguards in connection with power of entry conferred by warrant

- 5 A search warrant must—
 - (a) specify the name of the person who applied for it;
 - (b) specify the date on which it is issued;
 - (c) state that the warrant is issued under section 17 of this Act;
 - (d) specify each set of premises to be searched, or (in the case of an allpremises warrant) the person who is in occupation or control of premises to be searched, together with any premises to be searched that are under the person's occupation or control and can be specified;
 - (e) specify the offence to which the relevant evidence relates.
